Here's How it Works:

- A B'nai Tzedek fund is established in the child's name with the Jewish Community Foundation of Montreal (JCF)
- The JCF will match the initial donations amount up to \$750. Donations are tax receiptable.
- This fund will be professionally invested and managed with all other JCF funds and will be regulated by the current policies of the JCF.
- The child can then choose to grant up to 5% annually from their fund balance to any Canadian Registered Charity.
- Donations to their B'nai Tzedek fund can be made at any time and the fund will grow in perpetuity.
